California's Proposition 65

Also called the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act, was enacted in 1986, as part of the law.

The State is required to publish a list of chemicals that are "Known" to the State of California to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity. The list is updated once a year and now contains about 800 different chemicals. The complete list can be viewed on the California Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) website www.oehha.org/prop65.html

As part of the law, businesses selling products to people in California must provide "clear and reasonable warnings if one or more listed chemicals may be in their product, even if it is only present in trace quantities. This warning is often in the form of a label on the product or its packaging. In compliance with this law certain Sapo products will appear with the following warning on the package:

<p>Warning: This product contains a chemical known to the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.</p>

Packaging Note:

When the above warning is called for, it will be provided on the specific package offered for sale, and not necessarily on every individual part within that package for sale. For example, a bag of 10 parts may be offered for sale "as 1 bag" containing the 10 parts, and the warning may be printed on the bag only
